Tri-County Fair Pig Wrestling Rules



Thank you for participating in our 4th annual Pig Wrestling Contest at the Tri-County Fair! The purpose of this event is to provide a way for the TCF and its attendees to give back to our local community, as well as have some good clean (or not so clean) fun!! All proceeds will be awarded to local non-profit organizations chosen by the first and second place teams in each category.

Rules:

- Four people per team
- Peewee, Junior and High School categories are coed, and will have a shorter barrel to place the pig in
- Winners will be determined by official time-keepers and judges
- There is a 2 minute time limit for the Pee Wee category and 1 minute time limit for the other categories.
- All players must start with one hand on the starting fence
 - The pig handler will release the pig into the ring
 - The timer will blow the whistle to signify when the team can start
- The pig must be placed in the barrel rear-end first
- No artificial catching devices can be used
- No unnecessary cruelty, i.e. hitting, kicking, stunning, the animal is allowed
- Time will stop when the pig is placed in the barrel and **all team members raise both hands in the air**
- All team members must stay and help unload the pig from the barrel and help get the pig back in the pen
- Judges and time-keepers decisions are final

Please dress for mud!

- Proper footwear must be worn
- Participants are **NOT** allowed to use the bathrooms to clean-up
- A wash station will be available for clean-up
- Participants are not allowed in the building facilities until they are cleaned-up

Check- In Time

- The team check-in time is between 5:00p.m.-5:30p.m., Friday, September 2, 2011
- The teams will check in at the East end of the track near the grassy area

Team's Charity of Choice

- Teams must choose a valid, local non-profit organization to receive the winnings
- The committee will determine the legitimacy of the team's charity
- Awards will be presented to the first and second place teams in each category
- * **All proceeds go to charity!** We encourage the participants and sponsors to donate additional money to help increase the contribution to charity.
